

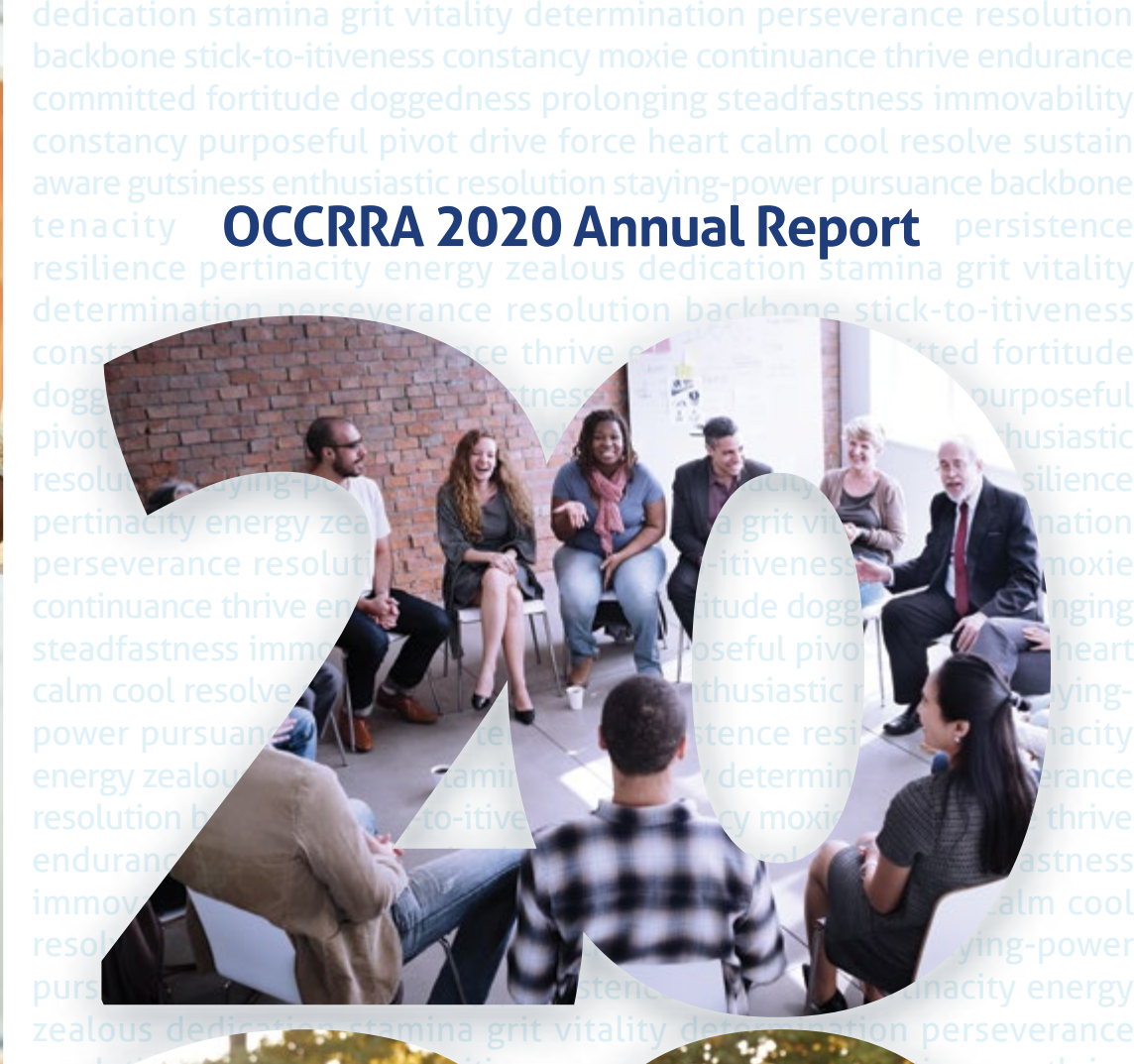
## A Letter from our CEO
