


EISC Transition- 5YR Credential

If you have a Service Coordinator I, II, or III, or a Supervisor of Service Coordinators credential, follow these steps to renew to the **EISC Transition 5-year** application:

1. Log in to your Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) profile or create one by using this [Create Profile User Guide](#).
2. Required Trainings:
 - a. Professional Development completion date on or before August 2, 2020 – Professional Development (PD) certificates/MyLearning transcript accepted for review. Upload to the Prof. Development section of your profile for review
 - b. Professional Development completion date on or after August 3, 2020 – PD completion must be verified automatically via MyLearning. Make sure your first name, last name, and email address are **exactly the same** in your OPR Account and MyLearning account for training completion verification. If they are not verified, after following those directions and waiting 24 hours, contact DODD ITS Call Center ITSCallCenter@dodd.ohio.gov for **course completion verification**
3. Click on the Applications section of your profile, **scroll down**, and then **click Action of your currently issued credential you wish to renew into the 5-year Transition**

4. Click Renew
5. In the application, select the correctly corresponding Professional Development in each drop down. The PD needs to be displayed in the Professional Development section for them to show up in the drop down.

Notes

- If you have a Supervisor 5-year Transition credential, you do not need to renew an expiring Service Coordinator credential. Per Ohio DODD, the Supervisor 5-year Transition credential allows you to provide services to families.
 - Make sure you have completed *Individualized Family Service Plan Overview* to meet the requirement. *IFSP It's All About the Process* does not count toward the credential requirement.
 - The Renew link which will take you to the Transition application is accessible as soon as 90 days before the date of expiration.
6. Submit the application
